Free Child Car Seat Safety Checks

Royal Berkshire Fire and Rescue Service (RBFRS) has joined forces with Wokingham Borough Council's Road Safety team to offer two free child car seat safety check events. The first event will take place on Thursday 7th February at Morrisons, Woosehill, Wokingham, from 9.30am-2.30pm. The second is on Friday 8th February at Asda, Lower Earley, from 9.30am-2.30pm.

A staggering 80% of child car seats are incorrectly fitted, which could potentially cause serious injuries or even death in the event of a road traffic collision (RTC). RBFRS Community Safety staff will check that child seats are fitted correctly in people's own vehicles and show them how to carry out their own safety checks in future. Wokingham Borough Council's Road Safety team will also be on hand to provide road safety information and advice.

Dan Ford, Community Safety team member, said: "Firefighters see the devastating aftermath of RTCs all too often and they are particularly tragic when babies and young children are involved. As part of our ongoing commitment to road safety we are delighted to be able to offer these free child car seat safety checks and hope that lots of people will take advantage of the scheme.

"You don't need to book an appointment, just turn up at any time between 9.30am 2.30pm on either day and ask a member of the Community Safety team. It's not often you can pick up something truly lifesaving with your shopping but getting your child's car seat safety checked could save their life."
