

What is **SAFE** ?

Our experience shows that early intervention and education can help to address the issues of fire-setting behaviours.

Royal Berkshire Fire and Rescue Service has trained and experienced practitioners who can offer help at an early stage to those needing assistance e.g. if you have a concern about someone with an unhealthy interest in fire.

How does it work ?

After an initial assessment to consider the person's needs, a number of sessions may be offered. These are tailored to the individual. As part of the service we will also provide a Home Fire Safety Check which gives advice on how to reduce or prevent fires in the home.
