ABOUT ROYAL BERKSHIRE FIRE AND RESCUE SERVICE

Royal Berkshire Fire and Rescue Service (RBFRS) provides cover 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, from 17 fire stations across the County, stretching from Slough and Langley in the east to Lambourn and Newbury in the west.

The role of RBFRS within local communities is evolving. A wide range of services help keep communities safe, including safety and protection advice to residents and businesses, as well as enforcing

fire safety legislation and reducing fire risk in the built environment. This is in addition to highly skilled crews providing a swift and effective response to incidents ranging from road, rail, aviation and waterway accidents, to fuel and chemical spills, collapsed buildings, large animal rescues and, of course, fires.

In 2020-21, our crews responded to 6,642 incidents. In addition, we work alongside teams in the six unitary authorities of Berkshire, as well as, Thames Valley Police, South Central Ambulance Service (SCAS), Public Health, and other public service providers in Berkshire.

In doing so, RBFRS is helping to reduce community risk and contribute to the overall safety of the communities we serve, whilst still providing a value-for-money service to the local taxpayer.

Within the last few years, Royal Berkshire Fire and Rescue Service has received and been shortlisted for a number of regional and national awards.

In July 2019, the Service was judged as 'good' for: effectively keeping people safe and secure from fire and other risks; efficiently keeping people safe and secure from fire and other risks; and looking after its people. This was followed by an inspection in 2020 which confirmed that RBFRS has "adapted and responded to the pandemic effectively."


